Minutes: A motion was made by Lynn Bianchi and seconded by Peter Feltner to accept the minutes, from March 3, 2010, as amended. The board members passed the motion.

Treasurer's Report: A motion was made by Gay Lenhard and seconded by Joyce Lobene to approve the monthly financial report for March 2010. The board members passed the motion.

President's Report: David shared a Thank-you card received from award receipt Sandy Ville.

Town of Ogden:

Gay reported that a new Sheriff sub-station will be developed at Union Street and Route 531.

Gay also reported on a meeting she attended regarding the Spencerport Volunteer Ambulance. The ambulance is experiencing financial difficulty and made a presentation to representatives of the Towns of Ogden and Parma, and the Village of Spencerport. The Ambulance Department will hold future meetings to address possible solutions to resolve the crisis.

Joyce reported on village news by discussing the construction work continuing in the Village Plaza. The work is progressing well there and will continue thru the next couple of months. The new Tim Hortons on Union Street opened and a ribbon cutting ceremony was held. Also opened in the village on Union Street is a new Men's shop, called Incognito. Both businesses will be welcomed additions to the village.

Joyce reported that spring clean-up is beginning throughout the village. Also the village will vote on the budget at a meeting to be held April 7.

Membership: Pat Hamann reported that we currently have a total of 146 members with 4 members renewing and 1 new member added the past month.

Golf Tournament: Gay reported that this year's golf tournament will be on July 19th at Pinewood Country Club.

Youth Hall of Fame: Lynn Bianchi reported that there are 8 candidates (4 girls and 4 boys). The ceremony will be held on May 12 at 5:30 in the Library Meeting Room.

Public Relations: Carol Nellis-Ewell reported that the Chamber monthly lunch meeting location for May will change to the Lighthouse Dinner. Carol will post the change on the Chamber website.

New Business:

Ginny Swarhout requested the Chamber again this year support the Spencerport Canal Days Committee event. In the past the Chamber has donated \$1000 to the Friday evening concert. Keith Ryan made a motion to donate \$1,000 to the concert cost. Joyce Lobene seconded, the motion was passed.

Joyce said the village merchants' monthly meeting will be held on April 8. The merchants are continuing work on a car window decal to promote "Shop Spencerport". The merchants are also planning a Spring Event for Saturday, May 22. This event will feature a sidewalk sale and flea market with donations going to the Red Cross Disaster Relief fund. Joyce will update us on the details for both events as they are made.

David Haines reported on the Rochester Area Chamber of Commerce Mega Mixer to be held on Wednesday, May 5 at the RIT Inn & Conference Center. David will send a brochure to all Chamber members regarding the mixer.
